Fund Description

The fund seeks the highest level of long-term total return consistent with its asset allocation. Total return consists of both capital appreciation and income, with the fund placing an increasing emphasis on fixed income investments as the target date 2055 approaches, and reaching its final and most conservative asset allocation in approximately five years after the target year.

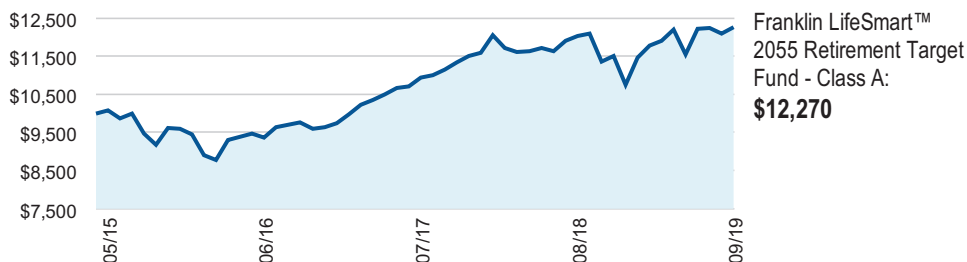

What Are the Risks?

Glossary

Beta: A measure of the fund's volatility relative to the market, as represented by the stated Index. A beta greater than 1.00 indicates volatility greater than the market.

Standard Deviation: A measure of the degree to which a fund's return varies from the average of its previous returns. The larger the standard deviation, the greater the likelihood (and risk) that a fund's performance will fluctuate from the average return.

Effective 5/1/19, the fund made changes to its glide path and asset allocation, including removing its strategic allocation to alternative investments. Such changes can impact performance. The fund's investment goal has remained the same.

Top Ten Holdings: The portfolio manager for the fund reserves the right to withhold release of information with respect to holdings that would otherwise be included.

Fund Measures: ^The fund's blended benchmark is an allocation of 95% MSCI AC World Index and 5% Bloomberg Barclays Multiverse Index. Allocations for the Fund's Blended Benchmark reflect or map the Fund's current target asset class allocations and may not be representative of the Fund's historical asset class allocations. Performance for the Blended Benchmark is based on an asset class allocation that matches the glide path of the Franklin LifeSmart Funds over time. Prior to May 1, 2019, the Blended Benchmark had an allocation to FTSE 3-Month U.S. T-Bill Index. Such changes impact performance.
